2. Earlier when in a departmental proceeding 100% pension was withheld, the same was challenged by the petitioner in C.W.J.C. No. 10531 of 2000. The same was partly allowed by order dated 07.09.2010 and the order was modified by holding that the



petitioner would be entitled for payment of gratuity and 90% of pension and that too from the date of the order.

3. Having regard to the aforesaid and the fact that nobody has appeared to press the writ petition, the same stands dismissed.
