2 06-03-2018 This writ petition has been filed for release of a vehicle

(Pulsar Motorcycle-150) bearing Registration No. BR 33 S
4454, which has been seized in connection with Mithanpura P.S.

Case No. 352 of 2017 due to violation of the Bihar Prohibition
and Excise Act, 2016.

It is common ground that in various cases, identical in
nature, pending finalization of the criminal case, vehicles have
been directed to be released by this Court on various conditions
and we see no reason to make a deviation in the present case.

Keeping in view the aforesaid, it is directed that pending
finalization of the criminal case, the aforesaid vehicle in
question shall be released to the petitioner on her furnishing two



sureties to the satisfaction of District Magistrate, Muzaffarpur within a period of one week from the date of her furnishing the sureties and further undertaking to produce the vehicle as and when directed by the authority concerned and not to alienate or deal with the vehicle in question in any manner during the pendency of the criminal case.

With the aforesaid, the writ petition stands allowed and disposed of.
