ORAL ORDER

3 12-02-2018 The parties are in agreement that the present case can be disposed off with a direction to dispose off the pending departmental proceeding within a period of three months from today and, failing which the order of suspension shall stand revoked automatically.

In view of the agreement of the parties, I direct that the disciplinary authority shall dispose off the pending departmental proceeding within a period of three months from today and in default thereof the suspension order of the petitioner shall stand revoked automatically.

It goes without saying that the petitioner shall



cooperate in the pending departmental proceeding and if the petitioner fails to cooperate, the respondents shall be free to bring the same to the notice of the Court by filing an interlocutory application.

The writ petition is **disposed off** in the aforesaid terms.
