ORAL ORDER

2 21-02-2018 The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied if he is permitted to file a representation before the respondent no. 2 regarding grant of benefit of A.C.P and M.A.C.P. and the respondent no. 2 be directed to dispose of the said representation within a specified time frame.

Accordingly, it is directed that the petitioner may file a representation regarding his grievances before the respondent no. 2 and the respondent no. 2 is directed to dispose of the said representation within a period of four weeks thereafter.

While passing the final order, the concerned respondent may consider the notification dated 18.05.2009 which has been



annexed as Annexure-2 to the writ petition and such other materials which may be placed by the petitioner along with his representation.

In case any consequential benefit is found payable, the same shall be paid within a period of four weeks from the date of passing of the said order.

The writ petition is disposed of on the aforesaid terms.
