Delay of 38 days in filing of the appeal is condoned
and I.A. No. 3568 of 2017 stands allowed and disposed of.

With regard to payment of compound interest on the
death-cum-retiral benefit which was to be paid to the petitioner
after the death of his father, the learned Writ Court has dismissed
the writ petition, primarily on the ground that the claim was made
by the petitioner's mother and thereafter by the petitioner after a
period of more than 30 years on the ground of delay and laches and



in doing so, in our considered view, the learned Writ Court has not committed any error warranting re-consideration.

The appeal is, therefore, dismissed.
