Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that model three answers were incorrect and as such the petitioner is entitled to the benefit for answering question nos. 21, 42 and 96. He submits that he has represented the BPSC vide Annexure-5 dated 6.8.2018 which is still pending.

Considering the fact that representation of the petitioner is pending before the BPSC, the writ petition is disposed of with direction to the BPSC to dispose of the
