Heard learned counsel for the parties.

In this case, the petitioners have submitted that this case is governed by the judgment dated 11.08.2015 in L.P.A. No. 1489 of 2011 which relates to retrenched persons of Non-Formal Supervisor and Non-Formal Instructors which ultimately succeeded up to the Honb'le Apex Court in S.L.P. No. 32079 of 2015 but, in the present case, from Annexure-1 itself, it appears that the petitioners were neither appointed as a Supervisor nor Instructor.



In that view of the matter, the case of the petitioners are not governed by the aforesaid judgment passed in L.P.A. No. 1489 of 2011 and S.L.P. No. 32079 of 2015.

This writ application is, accordingly, dismissed.
