2 09-04-2018 The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied if he is permitted to file a representation before the respondent no. 2 regarding his grievances mentioned in the writ petition and the respondent no. 2 be directed to dispose of the said representation within a specified time frame.

Accordingly, it is directed that the petitioner may file a representation regarding his grievances within two weeks and in case such representation is filed before the respondent no. 2, then the same may be considered and disposed of within a period of



four weeks from the date of filing of the said representation by a speaking and reasoned order considering the notification dated 05.02.1985 issued by the Finance Department, Government of India, Ministry of Finance, Bureau of Public Enterprises.

The writ petition is disposed of on the aforesaid terms.
