of the claim confirms the compliance of the direction of this Court
passed on the writ petition, whereby a direction was given to the
District Animal Husbandry Officer to consider the grievance of



the petitioner as regarding release of subsidy and to dispose of the same in accordance with law. The petitioner, if so aggrieved by the order, would be at liberty to question the same before an appropriate forum by filing an appropriate application but for the present no case for contempt is made out and the contempt application is accordingly disposed of.
