Apart from the fact that there is an inordinate unexplained delay of about three years in filing of the appeal, the matter pertains to appointment of Lady Supervisors on contract basis. The learned Writ Court on merit has upheld the order passed by the District Magistrate, Darbhanga. Taking note of the various considerations made by the learned Writ Court and the fact that there is a delay of about three years when during this



period of three years, rights for appointment to the posts have accrued to various persons, we are not inclined to grant any indulgence merely because the petitioner has arisen from the hibernation.

Accordingly, finding no justification to condone the delay, the application for condonation stands dismissed and consequently the appeal also.
