Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

From perusal of various annexures it appears that certificate of the petitioner passing TET examination is subject-matter of vigilance enquiry and the Investigating Officer has requested the Examination Controller of the Bihar School Examination Board to furnish details with regard to passing of TET examination by the petitioner. From Annexure-6 it appears that the Vigilance was directed to undertake investigation in the light of the direction in CWJC No. 15459 of 2014.

In view of the above, no positive direction can be issued for payment of salary to the petitioner. However, the respondent-



authorities are required to take final decision, if not already taken, as to the validity of the passing of TET examination within three months from today and the payment of salary will abide by the final outcome of the enquiry.

It is submitted on behalf of the petitioner that in view of the fact that the Bihar School Examination Board has issued certificate, Annexure-7, the certificate of the petitioner appears to be genuine.

It is made clear that this Court has not expressed any opinion either on the merit of the case or on the genuineness of the certificate of passing TET examination by the petitioner. It is for the Vigilance to submit report in terms of the direction of this Court after enquiry into the matter.

With the aforesaid observations, the writ petition stands disposed of.
