ORAL ORDER

2 29-10-2018 The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied in case, the petitioner is given liberty to file a representation regarding his grievances mentioned in the writ petition and the concerned authority is directed to dispose of the same within a specified time frame.

Accordingly, the petitioner is directed to file a representation within a period of four weeks from today before the Respondent No. 4 and the Respondent No. 4 is directed to dispose of the same within a period of eight weeks thereafter, failing which the said authority shall be visited with penal consequences.

It is further directed that in case, the admitted dues are



not paid within a period of eight weeks from passing of the final order, the same shall carry an interest of 18% per annum for the period during which the admitted dues had remained pending for payment.

The writ petition is disposed of on the aforesaid terms.
