The learned counsel for the parties are in agreement that since the notice inviting tender for the purposes of mid-day meal was issued in the month of February, 2018, nothing survives in the writ petition at the moment, however the learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the filing of the present writ petition may not be taken to be an impediment in the petitioner's participation in the next year's tender.

Accordingly, the present writ petition is disposed of as having become infructuous, however with an observation that if any tender is notified for the next year, the suitability and



eligibility of the petitioner shall be considered on its own merit
without being influenced by any other consideration.
