2. The present writ petition has been filed for a direction
to the Collector, Vaishali (respondent no. 1) to dispose of the appeal
bearing no. R-309/2016-17 (Bhola Singh vs. Sub-Divisional Officer,
Mahua, P.D.S. Appeal) against the letter no. 66 dated 20.01.2015 passed
by the Sub-Divisional Officer, Mahua, District- Vaishali (Annexure-4)
whereby the license of the petitioner has been cancelled.

petitioner has already filed an appeal being Appeal No. R-309/2016-17
