Keeping in view the nature of allegations made, which is vague, unspecific and lacking in specific details with regard to the irregularities in question, we are not inclined to interfere into the matter in a Public Interest Litigation exercising our extraordinary jurisdiction under Article 226 of the Constitution. If the petitioner has any grievance, he should file a properly constituted complaint giving all specific details with regard to the irregularities and if that is done, the Chief Vigilance Authorities of the State Government or the Lokayukta Organization are competent enough to deal with the matter.



With the aforesaid observation and liberty to the petitioner, we dispose of the writ petition.
