2     09-01-2018             This writ petition has been filed for release of a vehicle  
  
(Motorcycle Suzuki Hayate) bearing Registration No. BR 0BL  
  
3588 which has been seized due to violation of the provisions of  
  
the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016 in connection with  
  
Ara Mufassil P.S. Case No. 189 of 2017.

It is common ground that in various cases, similar petitions  
have been allowed and pending finalization of the confiscation  
proceedings, seized vehicle has been directed to be released.

Keeping in view the aforesaid, pending finalization of the



confiscation and criminal proceedings, the vehicle in question, shall be released to the petitioner on his furnishing two sureties to the satisfaction of the District Magistrate, Bhojpur at Ara within one week from the date of furnishing the sureties, subject to the condition that the petitioner shall make available the vehicle in question before the authority concerned as and when directed and further that he shall undertake not to alienate the vehicle or deal with it in any manner whatsoever during the pendency of the confiscation proceedings so as to cause adverse effect or prejudice to the State Government.

With the aforesaid, the petition stands disposed of.
