In case the petitioner has any grievance with regard to the resolution passed by the Gram Panchayat, filing of Public Interest Litigation under Article 226 of the Constitution, is not the appropriate remedy for the petitioner. Under the Bihar Panchayat Raj Act itself statutory provisions are available for filing complaints and challenging the resolution and, therefore, indulgence into the matter in a Public Interest Litigation is not called for.

Granting liberty to the petitioner to take recourse to the statutory remedy of approaching the authorities under the



Bihar Panchyat Raj Act and the rules framed thereunder, the writ petition stands disposed of.
