ORAL ORDER

2 09-03-2018 The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied if he is permitted to file a representation before the respondent no. 7 regarding his grievances and the respondent no. 7 be directed to dispose off the said representation within a specified time frame.

Accordingly, it is directed that the petitioner may file a representation regarding his grievances within two weeks and in case such representation is filed, then the same may be considered and disposed off within a period of four weeks thereafter,



considering the fact that on the basis of the patient register and other reports submitted by the petitioner, the cases of other persons who are the compounders have already been considered and their salary has been released by the respondent no. 7 vide Memo No. 282 dated 28.06.2017.

The writ petition is disposed off on the aforesaid terms.
