Education Officer, Lakari Naviganj, Siwan, dated 7th September,



2017 (Annexure 4), whereby the Block Education Officer requested the District Programme Officer (Establishment), Siwan, to issue guideline in the matter of compassionate appointment of the petitioner

Referring to the aforesaid, the learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the writ application may be disposed of with a direction to the respondents to take final decision on the claim of the petitioner on compassionate appointment considering the hardship of the financial position of the family on the death of the bread earner.

In the light of Annexure 4, the writ application is **disposed of** with a direction to the respondent-District Programme Officer (Establishment), Siwan, respondent no. 4, to take final decision in the matter of compassionate appointment of the petitioner with a maximum period of sixty days from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order.
