ORAL ORDER

2 20-04-2018 The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied in case, she is permitted to file a representation regarding her grievance mentioned in the writ petition, before the respondent no. 2.

Accordingly, it is directed that the petitioner may file a representation before the respondent no. 2 within a period of two weeks from today and the respondent no. 2 shall dispose of the same by a reasoned and speaking order within a period of four



weeks thereafter, failing which, the concerned authority shall be visited with penal consequences. The concerned authority shall consider the fact that earlier also similar type of order was passed and the same was quashed by this Hon’ble Court, whereafter the earlier order of transfer was recalled.

The writ petition is disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
