petitioners submits that the case of the petitioners is fully covered by Annexures-5 i.e. order dated 31.03.2011 in C.W.J.C. No. 6139 of 2007 and Annuehre-10, the order passed by the L.P.A. Bench in L.P.A. No. 756 of 2015 dated 16.08.2017.

In view of the above, the writ application is disposed of with a direction to the District Programme Officer (Establishment), Siwan to examine the case of the petitioners in the light of the decision of this Court as indicated hereinabove within a maximum period of 60 days from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order and extend the same benefit to the petitioners if it is found covered by the decision in L.P.A. in view of the litigation policy of the State Government.
