Heard learned counsel for the petitioners, learned counsel for the complainant and learned APP for the State.

It is submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioners that only general and omnibus allegations have been made against the petitioners who are *Nanad* and *Devar* respectively of the victim.

Learned counsel for the complainant pointed out, with reference to paragraphs 6 and 13 of the complaint petition that specific allegations have been made against the two petitioners and, as such, there is no ground for quashing the order dated 11.06.2010 taking cognizance of the offence under Sections 498A, 406, 323, 379, 504/34 of Indian Penal code.



On going through the complaint petition, this Court finds that there is sufficient material to arrive at a prima facie conclusion for taking cognizance and, as such, the order taking cognizance, impugned in the instant petition, does not suffer from any infirmity.

This application is dismissed.
