2 14-03-2018 The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied if he is permitted to file a representation before the respondent no. 6 regarding his grievances mentioned in the writ petition and the respondent no. 6 be directed to dispose off the said representation within a specified time frame.

Accordingly, it is directed that the petitioner may file a
