1. The writ petitioner, by way of the present writ petition, has prayed for issuance of direction to appoint the petitioner on the compassionate ground in light of the order passed by the Hon'ble Apex Court *dated 03.04.2017* in *Civil Appeal no. 4776-4777 of 2017*.
