Heard Mr. Surendra Kumar Mishra, learned
counsel for the petitioner and Mr. Shailesh Kumar Singh, AC to
GP-5.

The present Writ application has been filed for
quashing the order dated 06.03.2017, as contained in Annexure-
12, passed by District Magistrate, Patna, whereby the petitioner's
application for grant of licence for SBBL gun has been rejected.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the
petitioner that the order of the District Magistrate is not in
consonance with the order dated 27.06.2016, as contained in
Annexure-11, passed in CWJC No. 9563 of 2016 by a Bench of
this Court.



Keeping in view the fact that there is a provision of statutory appeal under Section 18 of the Arms Act, 1959, this Court is not inclined to interfere. Accordingly, this application is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to prefer appeal along with the limitation petition and if the same is filed within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order, it is expected from the Appellate Authority to consider the condonation of delay in filing the appeal in view of the fact that the petitioner was pursuing his remedy before this Court and dispose of the appeal expeditiously in accordance with law.
