ORAL ORDER

2 04-05-2018 The learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners would be satisfied if they are permitted to file a representation before the respondent no. 5 regarding their grievances mentioned in the writ petition and the respondent no. 5 be directed to dispose of the said representation within a specified time frame.
