The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied in case, he is permitted to file a representation regarding his grievances mentioned in the writ petition, before the respondent no. 2.

Accordingly, it is directed that the petitioner may file a representation before the respondent no. 2 within a period of two weeks from today and the respondent no. 2 shall dispose of the same by a reasoned and speaking order within a period of four weeks thereafter, failing which, the concerned authority shall be



visited with penal consequences. It is needless to state that if any consequential benefit is required to be paid to the petitioner, the same shall be paid within a period of four weeks from passing of the final order.

The writ petition is disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
