ORAL ORDER

2 30-04-2018 Heard the parties.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in connection with
Basopatti P.S.Case No.10 of 2018 , registered for offences
punishable under Sections 406 and 420 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegation against the petitioner is he has taken
Rs.1,57,000/- for sending the son of the informant to foreign and
his son was sent to Malaysia on wrong Visa causing mental and
economical loss to him.

Submission of the learned counsel for the petitioner is that
even from the FIR it appears that he has sent the son of the
informant to Malaysia on wrong visa but nothing specific has been
attributed against him.

Heard learned A.P.P. also.



Having heard both sides and in view of the facts and circumstances, as stated above, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of the order, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned A.C.J.M. Vth, Madhubani in connection with Basopatti P.S.case No.10 of 2018 dated 15.1.2018, subject to condition as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

With following conditions :

- (i) One of the bailors of the petitioner shall be a local person having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the concerned court.
- (ii) The petitioner will not induce any witness or tamper with the evidence.
- (iii) The petitioner shall co-operate in the investigation of the case and make himself available as and when required by the Police, otherwise, the prosecution is free to move for cancellation of his bail bond.

With the aforesaid direction, this application is allowed.
