At the outset, Mr. Ganpati Trivedi, learned Senior Advocate for Bihar Hindu Religious Trust Board pointed out that against the order of Bihar Hindu Religious Trust Board Tribunal, a miscellaneous appeal would lie before this Court under sub-section (4) of Section 43-A of the Bihar Hindu Religious Trust Act, 1950.
