ORAL ORDER

3 19-06-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner, State as well as learned counsel for the respondents.

From the pleadings, it appears that entire facts was not placed before this court and as such the court is constraint to recall the interim order passed by this court vide order dated 18.05.2018.
