2 08-05-2018 The petitioner is aggrieved by the order dated 6.11.2017 passed by the District Programme Officer, East Champaran, Motihari as also the consequential order dated 11.11.2017 passed by the Child Development Project Officer, Adapur, East Champaran.

The learned counsel for the petitioner has referred to the policy decision contained in letter of the Director, ICDS



contained in Memo No. 2005 dated 27.4.2013 and has contended that shifting of the ward has been stayed.
