ORAL ORDER

2 28-08-2018 Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in view of the order passed in Civil Appeal No. 2795-2797 of 2017 (Chandra Gupta Kumar & Ors. Vs. State of Bihar & Ors. etc.), the petitioners should be given liberty to represent before the authority concerned and has drawn attention of this Court



towards paragraph no.12 of the aforesaid order, which reads as follows:-

“12. We make it clear that we have not considered the merits of the selection already conducted pursuant to our order dated 20.04.2017. In case anyone has any grievance with regard to the same, he shall be free to take recourse to any other remedy before appropriate forum.”

This Court is not examining the merit of the case and the authority concerned, on the basis of material available on record, will consider the case of the petitioners and will pass orders in accordance with law.

With the aforementioned observation, this writ application is disposed of.
