2 31-07-2018 *Inter alia* contending that contrary to the transfer policy, various Pharmacists have been posted in the Medical Colleges and Hospitals in the State of Bihar beyond the stipulated period contained in the executive policy, this writ petition has been filed for transfer of Pharmacists posted in the Medical Colleges and Hospitals in the State of Bihar.

Apart from finding the public spirited antecedents of the petitioner to be doubtful, we are of the considered view that for the purpose of executing a transfer policy, a public interest



litigation of the nature is not permissible. We, therefore, dismiss
the writ petition.
