The following reliefs have been sought for by the
petitioners in the present writ application.

“1. That this writ application in the nature



of Mandamus is being filed for issuance a direction to the respondents to consider the case of the petitioners in the light of judgment of Hon'ble Apex Court in case of Mukesh & Anothers Vs The State of Bihar and Ors (reported in 2017(5) SCC 383) for grant of regular pay protection/suitable relief of regular protection to the petitioners, for which the representations of the petitioners are still pending before the respondents for kind consideration. This writ petition is also being filed for other reliefs as well.”

It has been submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that the case of the petitioners is squarely covered by the order passed by another Co-ordinate Bench of this Court in C.W.J.C. No. 8963 of 2018 dated 11.05.2018.
