Referring to the show cause filed on behalf of the opposite party nos. 2, 3 & 4, learned counsel for the State submits that the cheque bearing No. 763288 dated 01.10.2016 for Rs. 37,252/- has been issued to the petitioner and the same was deposited by him in his account existing in the Bihar Gramin Bank, Purabsarai, Munger.
