ORAL ORDER

3 28-03-2018 Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner as

well as the learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner wants to renew his prayer for bail
which was earlier rejected by orders dated 13.07.2016 and
12.07.2017 passed in Cr. Misc. Nos. 22876 of 2016 and 20360 of
2017, on the ground that the petitioner is suffering in custody
since 30.09.2015 and up till now the trial has not been concluded
and in the near future the trial is not likely to be concluded and as
such the petitioner deserves sympathetic consideration.

The learned A.P.P. opposes prayer for bail of the
petitioner by submitting that the petitioner is the assailant and the
postmortem report is consistent with the prosecution version.

In the facts and circumstances stated above,



finding no good ground for reconsideration of prayer for bail, again prayer for bail of the petitioner stands rejected in connection with Sessions Trial No. 549 of 2016 arising out of Dulhin Bazar P.S. Case No. 141 of 2015 pending in the court of the Additional Sessions Judge-VII, Danapur, Patna.

However, considering detention of the petitioner, let the trial be expedited and concluded as early as possible preferably within a period of four months from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order.
