2 22-03-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and
learned APP for the State.

Petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for
the offences punishable under Section 379 of the Indian
Penal Code and later on Section 411 of the Indian Penal
Code was added.

The FIR of the theft of Auto-Rickshaw is
against unknown.

Submission is that nothing was recovered
from possession of the petitioner. Petitioner is in custody
since 23.09.2017. Investigation is already complete.

Considering the aforesaid facts, let the
petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing
bail bond of Rs.20,000/- (Twenty Thousand) with two



sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court below where the case is pending in connection with Mufassil Police Station Case No.164 of 2017, subject to the condition that the petitioner shall fully cooperate with the trial of the case, failing which the court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioner.
