2 09-03-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and

learned APP for the State.

Petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the
offences punishable under Sections 376 and 313 of the Indian
Penal Code.

The informant claims to be wife of the petitioner.
Hence, submission is that offence under Section 376 of the Indian
Penal Code is not applicable as the victim was a major and had
voluntarily entered into marriage with the petitioner.

Considering the aforesaid fact, let the petitioner,
above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of
Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the
like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court below where
the case is pending in connection with Sessions Trial No. 17 of



2018 arising out of Mahila Police Station Case No. 26 of 2017, subject to the condition that the petitioner shall fully cooperate with the trial of the case, failing which the court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioner.
