3 05-04-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
counsel for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in **Antichak P.S. Case No. 38 of 2016** registered for the offence punishable under Sections 342, 376 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 4 of the POCSO Act.

Informant is the victim who in her written statement before the police has alleged that petitioner developed physical relation with her on the promise of getting married with her. Subsequently, he refused to marry her and thereafter fled away from his residence. The victim was sent to medical examination and the medical board has assessed that she is less than 18 years but has found no physical injury on any part of her body or any recent sexual assault on her. Petitioner has got no criminal



antecedent and is in custody since 09.10.2017.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, let the petitioner named above be released on bail upon furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/-(ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned **A.D.J-1, Bhagalpur** in connection with **Antichak P.S. Case No. 38 of 2016.**
