learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner is accused in connection with Excise
Case No. 178 of 2017, registered under Section 30(a) of the Bihar
Prohibition and Excise Act.

The accusation is of recovery of 110 bottles, each
containing 300 ml, Nepali Soufia from the dickey of the
motorcycle, on which, two persons were found sitting. On seeing
the police party, they started to flee away, but on chased, one
person was apprehended, who disclosed his name as Sudama Rai
and also disclosed the name of this petitioner, who succeeded to
flee away.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that



petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case due to ulterior motive and he is in custody since 14.12.2017.

Having regard to the facts and the circumstances of the case, the petitioner above named, is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-(Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the 7th Additional Sessions Judge-cum- Special Judge, Excise at Motihari, East Champaran, in connection with Excise Case No. 178 of 2017. Out of two sureties, one surety must be the close relative of the petitioner.
