2 02-05-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the
offence punishable under Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition
and Excise Act, 2016.

10.5 litres of foreign liquor is said to have been
recovered from the bag kept beneath the berth of the petitioner in
the railway coach and the petitioner was apprehended.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner
that no incriminating article has been recovered from the
conscious physical possession of the petitioner. He has no concern
either with the seized liquor or with the bag in question. He had no



knowledge of keeping of the aforesaid liquor beneath his berth. He has been falsely implicated in the case by the GRP personnel merely on suspicion. He has no criminal antecedent. He has been languishing in custody since 21.02.2018.

Considering the facts aforesaid, the above named petitioner is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Special Judge, Excise, Muzaffarpur in connection with Rail Muzaffarpur P.S. Case No. 28 of 2018.
