2 16-01-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioner is in custody in connection with Sherghati P.S. Case No.50 of 2017, a case under Section 392 of the Indian Penal Code.

The F.I.R. of the occurrence of robbery is against unknown. Name of the petitioner had transpired in the confessional statement of the co-accused.

The petitioner is in custody since 01.08.2017. Investigation is complete. The petitioner, however, was never put on Test Identification Parade nor anything was recovered from the possession of the petitioner. Aforesaid is the submission of the learned counsel for the petitioner.



Finding substance in the submission aforesaid, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.20,000/- (Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Court-below where the case is pending in connection with the aforesaid case, with condition that the petitioner shall fully cooperate with the investigation/trial of the case, failing which the court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioner.
