ORAL ORDER

2 11-04-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

The petitioner wants to renew the prayer of bail which was earlier rejected by order dated 23.05.2017, passed in Criminal Miscellaneous No. 14869 of 2017, on the ground that the petitioner is suffering in custody since 20.07.2015, other co-accused of this case are on bail, the trial has not been concluded within the time given by this Court and in near future the trial is not likely to be concluded.

The learned APP opposes the prayer of bail of the petitioner by submitting that the petitioner is the husband and the doctor has found several external injuries on the body of the deceased caused by hard and blunt substance. The witnesses



have supported the prosecution case during investigation.

In the facts and circumstances stated above, at present, finding no good ground for reconsideration of prayer for bail of petitioner, again his such prayer stands rejected in connection with S. Tr. No. 121 of 2016/85 of 2016, arising out of Amba P.S. Case No. 48 of 2015, pending in the Court of learned Additional Sessions Judge-VII, Aurangabad.

However, learned trial Court is again directed to expedite the trial and to conclude the same as early as possible, preferably within four months from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order.
