APP for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in connection with Sherghati
P.S. Case no. 93 of 2018 registered under Section 30(a) of Bihar
Prohibition & Excise Act-2016.

25 lts. of country made liquor is said to have been
recovered from the motorcycle of the petitioner and petitioner
was apprehended on chase by the police.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner
that no incriminating article has been recovered from his
conscious physical possession. He has been falsely implicated
in the case by the police at the instance of his enemy while he
was passing through the place of occurrence. He has no concern



either with the seized liquor or with the motorcycle in question.
He has no criminal antecedent. He has been languishing in
custody since 19.02.2018.

In the facts and circumstances of the case, the
above named petitioner is directed to be enlarged on bail on
furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two
sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned
Special Excise Judge, Gaya in connection with Sherghati P.S.
Case no. 93 of 2018.
