2 08-03-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the

learned counsel for the State.

The petitioner is in custody since 01.08.2017 in
connection with Danapur P.S. Case No.546 of 2015 registered
for the offence under Sections 406 and 420 of the Indian Penal
Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
dispute relates to sale and purchase of land between the parties,
for which appropriate remedy is available to the informant. It is
further submitted that the petitioner has no criminal antecedents
and she has not executed any such agreement, as alleged in the
F.I.R. Thus, the petitioner prays for grant of regular bail.

Having considered the entire facts and circumstances



of the case and that the petitioner is languishing in jail for more than six months, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on her furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Danapur, in connection with Danapur P.S. Case No.546 of 2015.
