ORAL ORDER

2 03-04-2018 Heard learned counsels for the petitioners and the State.

The petitioners, already in custody since 20.11.2017, seek bail in connection with Dariyapur P.S.Case No. 295 of 2017 registered under Sections 147, 148, 302, 307, 323, 324, 341, 448, 504 and 506 of the Indian penal Code.

Allegation in brief is that one Dasharath Sah assaulted the informant's son with spear as a result he failed down, thereafter others assaulted with *lathi* and *danda*.

Submission is that specific allegation of doing assault with lethal weapon is against Dasharath Sah and no specific allegation against these petitioners and petitioner no. 1 is a married girl and petitioner no. 2 is her mother and there are injuries, out of which two are abrasion and other head injury is said to be fatal.



Having considered the aforesaid facts and circumstances, the petitioners, namely, Sarswati Devi alias Sarswati Kumari and Chhatiya Devi, being ladies, having no specific allegation of overt act, are directed to be released on bail upon furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned ACJM, Saran at Chapra in connection with Dariyapur P.S. Case No. 295 of 2017.
