No. 59 of 2014-15 and file an objection within a period of four weeks from today which shall be considered judiciously and in its proper perspective by the Certificate Officer, Supaul and a final order would be passed under Section 10 of the Bihar & Orissa Public Demand Recovery Act, 1914.

Till the final order is passed, no coercive steps shall be taken against the petitioner herein.

However, it is made clear that in case no fresh objection is filed within a period of four weeks from today, the Certificate Officer shall proceed ex parte.
