3 28-06-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
counsel for the State.

The petitioner is in custody since 03.01.2018 in
connection with Forbesganj P.S. Case No. 968 of 2017 for the
offence registered under Sections 302/34 of the Indian Penal
Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that only
on the basis of suspicion, the petitioner has been taken into
custody as it has been alleged that he alongwith other co-accused
persons were seen coming with the dead body of the deceased
boy. It is further submitted that similarly situated co-accused
person, namely, Sobhi Mandal @ Sobhi Kumar Mandal, who has
also named accused in the present case, has since been extended



the privilege of anticipatory bail vide order date 14.05.2018 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 20741 of 2018.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Araria in connection with Forbesganj P.S. Case No. 968 of 2017, subject to the following conditions :-

(1) one of the bailors will be his father.

(2) The petitioner shall not indulge himself in any similar offence till conclusion of the trial.

(3) The petitioner shall remain physically present in Court on each and every date during trial and in the event of his failure on two consecutive dates without sufficient reasons his bail bonds shall be liable to be cancelled by the learned Court concerned.

(4) The petitioner shall co-operate with the investigation, if not already concluded, and make himself available as and when so required and in case of failure, the State shall be at liberty to



move for cancellation of bail.
