2 22-02-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and
learned APP for the State.

Petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for
the offences punishable under Sections 395 of the Indian
Penal Code.

The FIR of the occurrence of dacoity is
against unknown. The petitioner has been remanded in this
case from some other case and he is in custody since
02.11.2017.

Submission is that nothing was recovered
from possession of the petitioner nor the petitioner was ever
put on T.I. Parade during investigation. Only material is
confessional statement of co-accused before the police.

Considering the aforesaid facts, let the



petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.20,000/- (Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court below where the case is pending in connection with Narpatganj Police Station Case No.83 of 2017, subject to the condition that the petitioner shall fully cooperate with the trial of the case, failing which the court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioner.
