counsel representing the State.

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in Bhagwan
Bazar P.S. Case No. 429 of 2017 registered for the offence under
Section 392 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that this
petitioner has got no criminal antecedent and the allegation that he
had purchased stolen motorcycle is not correct.

Considering the facts and circumstances, particularly
that the petitioner has no criminal antecedent, let the petitioner,
named above, be enlarged on bail on his furnishing bail bonds of
Rs. 15,000/- (Fifteen thousand) with two sureties of the like

Case No. 429 of 2017, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 437(3) Cr.P.C. and that in case he is found involved in similar kind of offence again the Investigating Officer will have liberty to move for cancellation of bail of the petitioner.
